USA FIGURE SKATING OLYMPIC HISTORY

US Olympic History: The United States has always been one of the dominant nations in figure skating, winning the most medals overall, and for men and women in singles competition. Figure skaters have also competed in two mixed events, pairs and dance, and in those competitions, we have fared less well, winning 9 medals, but yet to win an Olympic gold medal in a mixed figure skating event.

The US men's dominance started in 1948 when Dick Button won the gold medal at St. Moritz, which he repeated in 1952 at Oslo. Button's 1952 gold medal saw him ranked #1 by every judge in every phase of the competition, the only time this has ever happened at the Winter Olympics. Button was followed by US champions Hayes Alan Jenkins in 1956 and his brother, David Jenkins, in 1960. US men won the singles titles again in 1984 with Scott Hamilton, 1988 with Brian Boitano, and 2010 with Evan Lysacek.

US women started dominating figure skating in 1956 when Tenley Albright became the first ice queen. She was followed by Carol Heiss in 1960, who had been runner-up to Albright in 1956 as a 16-year-old and was World Champion five times consecutively, from 1956-60. Peggy Fleming won the gold in 1968, followed by Dorothy Hamill in 1976. US women's champions have since been Kristi Yamaguchi in 1992, Tara Lipinski in 1998, and Sarah Hughes in 2002.

There was a gap after the 1960 gold medals by Heiss and David Jenkins. In February 1961 the USA figure skating was flying to the World Championships in Prague, with a stopover in Brussels, Belgium, when their plane, Sabena Flight 548, crashed upon landing in Belgium. Everybody on board was killed including the entire US figure skating team. It required a huge effort even to field a team for the 1964 Winter Olympics in Innsbruck, a team mostly made up of young teenagers, few with international experience. Still, Scotty Allen came thru for an inspirational bronze medal in the men's singles, even though he was only 2 days short of his 15th birthday. Allen remains the youngest man to win an Olympic medal in figure skating, from any nation.

In pairs, the first US medalists were Sherwin Badger and Beatrix Loughran in 1932, followed by the brother/sister team of Pete and Karol Kennedy in 1952, both pairs winning silver medals. Since then the US has won silver medals in pairs in 1984 (Peter and Kitty Carruthers), and bronze medals in 1960 (Ron and Nancy Ludington), 1964 (Ron and Vivian Joseph), and 1988 (Peter Oppegard and Jill Watson), but no US pair has stood on the Olympic Podium since 1988.

In ice dancing, the US won a bronze medal the first time the event was contested at the Winter Olympics as a medal event, with James Millns and Colleen O'Connor winning bronze in 1976. But it would be 30 years before another dance medal for the US. In both 2006 and 2010 the United States has won silver medals in ice dancing at the Winter Olympics, with Ben Agosto and Tanith Belbin in 2006 and Charlie White and Meryl Davis in 2010.
