USA SNOWBOARDING OLYMPIC HISTORY

US Olympic History: Snowboarding became an Olympic sport in 1998 and the United States has always been among the leading nations in this sport. Both the American men and women have won the most medals in snowboarding of any nation, and the United States had the best overall performance at the 2002, 2006, and 2010 Winter Olympics.

Several of the snowboarders have become quite famous among American youths, with their penchant for extreme sports, notably Shaun White, Seth Wescott, Lindsey Jacobellis, Hannah Teter, and Gretchen Bleiler. Most inspirational is the story of Chris Klug, who competed for the US in snowboarding in 1998, 2002, and 2010. Klug suffered from primary sclerosing cholangitis, a liver disease, and between the 1998 and 2002 Winter Olympics, underwent a liver transplant, but then continued to compete.
